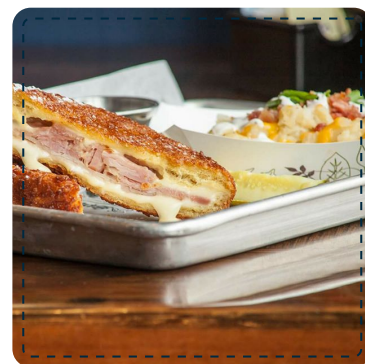




Taste the Flavor on a Day Trip
